

ASP Safety Fundamental Preparation Workshop

PM Review of Fundamentals – Physics, Probability and Statistics

Day 2

AM Recognizing Safety, Health and Environmental Hazards

PM Measuring, Evaluating and Controlling Safety, Health and Environmental Hazards

Day 3

AM Safety, Health and Environmental Training and Management

PM Business Principles, Practices, and Metrics in Safety, Health and Environmental Practice

Classes will be conducted from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm each day at the Constructors Association of Western Pennsylvania facility located at 1201 Banksville Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15216.
